

Data sharing agreement – Donald and Tarnagulla Microgrid Project

Dear resident/business,

In return for contributing your data to the Study, your household/business is eligible for a \$500 rebate upon the purchase of a solar and or battery system through the MASH program in Donald and Tarnagulla.

This rebate is funded through the Donald and Tarnagulla Microgrid Feasibility Study (Study) led by the Centre for New Energy Technologies (C4NET), with Central Victorian Greenhouse Alliance, Powercor, and Loddon and Buloke Shires as partners. The project assesses the feasibility of a local microgrid and is funded through the Federal Government's Regional and Remote Communities Reliability Fund. In order to access this rebate on top of any other state or federal government rebates you may be receiving, this data sharing agreement needs to be signed and returned to your installer during the sales process.

By signing this agreement you acknowledge and consent to:

1. CVGA providing:
 - a. your National Meter Identifier (NMI) to Powercor, who is your Distributed Network Service Provider;
 - b. your details to any party that requires them to administer and fund this rebate (including auditors appointed by those parties)
2. For Powercor to provide electricity meter data for your site including location within the grid (address) but otherwise de-identified basis to approved researchers contributing to the project, noting publication of results can only be on a fully de-identified basis;
3. CVGA having access to the data from your solar and/or battery system and being able to provide its operational data to approved researchers contributing to the project;
4. To utilise any survey data you choose to provide (the surveys will be optional for you to participate in); and
5. The personal information that CVGA collects is handled in accordance with the Privacy and Data Protection Act 2014 for the purposes of administering the rebate and contributing to the Study.

This data sharing agreement enables the project team to access and utilise your data as stated above for its technical modelling as part of the Study. By signing you also consent for your data to be used in future research that is an extension of or related to this Study.
